TECHNICIAN'S CORNER

AIR FLOW MEASUREMENT - The Heat Rise Method

Airflow is a critical component of the HVAC system. Air is the medium in which we most commonly deliver BTU's. It's often said that we cannot properly charge a system without correct airflow. If we get the refrigerant charge incorrect; we cannot deliver the correct BTUH and the system will not keep the space comfortable. It will cost more to operate by increasing the run time and most importantly we will not have delivered what we promised to our clients. Technicians have a few options to measure airflow:

- The Heat Rise Method
- Traverse the duct, converting feet per minute into cfm
- Use a Flow Hood to measure individual drops
- Measure the total external static pressure (TESP) compared the OEM's published fan table.

A properly trained technician will have all these methods at their disposal and use the appropriate method as the application warrants.

In this article I'd like to highlight the heat rise method. To get started we want make sure we have the right tools. A quick note; you want to have the best tools you can. Sometimes the "cheapest" is just that, cheap but not reliable. We need to trust our tools and keep them in good working condition. Remember the adage, "tools make the technician." The tools required for this task are a multi meter, amp clamp, digital thermometer and a calculator. The one thing to remember about this method is that we are measuring the temperature rise in the heat mode which means we are measuring the heating airflow. This is important to understand the cooling and heating airflow are typically different. A work around for this is to switch the fan speed for heat and cool for the test. Just remember to reset the fan speeds after the test. The formula is **BTUH Output** ÷ (**TD** * 1.08) with the 1.08 as an altitude correction factor (ACF). In our little slice of paradise, Palm Beach County, we are using the ACF of 1.08 since we are basically at sea level (less than 1,000' altitude).

For our example we will use the following measurements:

- 107° supply air temp
- 74° return air temp
- 235 volts
- 59 amps

<u>Step 1</u>: Turn the air handler on, in the heat mode. Let it operate and come up to temperature. Insert you temperature probe into the supply plenum (away from a direct line of site to the heater). Measure the supply air temperature, then measure the return air temperature. Record these.

<u>Step 2</u>: Measure and record the actual voltage and amp draw to the heater (making certain you're only measuring the heater amp draw, not the heater *and* fan). To find the BTUH output we multiply volts x amps x 3.413.

<u>Step3</u>: Input the collected data into the formula. The top of the formula is BTUH output (235 x 59) x 3.413. Reduced is, $13,865 \times 3.413 = 47,321$. The bottom of the formula is $(107^{\circ} - 74^{\circ}) \times 1.08$. Reduced is, $33 \times 1.08 = 35.6$.

Now the formula looks like this: $47,321 \div 35.6$ which equals 1,329 cfm. This cfm will most likely not equal 400 cfm per ton; however, that 400 cfm per ton is a nominal value. If your results are between 350 - 450 cfm per ton your airflow is generally acceptable. If the measured airflow is outside these parameters you will need to troubleshoot a little more.

I hope this information provides another tool for your "toolbox." Stay tuned to the PBACCA Plenum for more interesting tips and tools of our trade!






