TECHNICIAN'S CORNER

SYSTEM EVACUATION

This month's discussion is on the importance of properly evacuating a refrigerant system. System evacuation can be defined as: The removal of all vapors, gases and fluids from a refrigeration system. Typically two main types of evacuation are "deep vacuum" and "triple evacuation." The basic premise of the evacuation process is to lower the pressure in the refrigerant system. Pressure temperature relationship will allow moisture to boil off at a much lower temperature than 212°F. For example moisture will boil at 75°F at 29" hg (vacuum), this is equal to about 22k microns. One word of caution before we get to far into this topic; many of us have heard of technicians using the system compressor to create a vacuum. This is a bad idea for a few reasons but mostly because it will damage the compressor.

So, why evacuate? As mentioned above we need to remove all inert gases and liquid from the system; however, we can also verify that the system does not have any leaks. This will be evident by not achieving the vacuum we are looking for, 29.9". If a refrigeration system has a leak, the system will be unable to maintain a vacuum. Even after the vacuum pump has been turned off and the valve to the pump has been closed to isolate the system, the system pressure will continue to rise. Always repair leaks before performing an evacuation. Moisture in a closed refrigerant circuit will create an acid causing damage to the compressor motor, valve assembly and also has a potential to cause a real head scratcher. When moisture is present it can freeze at the metering device (pressure drop) causing a restriction. After the system is thawed for diagnosis the ice at the TXV, piston or metering device is gone. The system starts up "normally" and only until ice starts building again creating another restriction will it be seen. This often causes trouble for the technician who is not aware of this potential.

(Best Practice: Your nitrogen should already be out to purge the system while brazing. A small bleed of 3 psig nitrogen prevents carbonization from forming on the copper as its being brazed. This carbonization can and does create a restriction in the TXV and may partially block driers). The evacuation process begins by putting a small amount of nitrogen into the system, test the system for leaks. Is it holding pressure? Apply soap bubbles to the braze joints that were just made. Once you have verified there are no obvious leaks remove the nitrogen and set up the system for evacuation. With your valve stem removal tool remove the Schrader valve stems. Depending on the type of system you are working on the evacuation tools may change (i.e. commercial, VRF, residential); however, the basic processes are similar. Additionally, there are vacuum speed kits available to enable a better, faster process.

Evacuating a 10 ton system to 500 microns example

6' - 1/4" hose through the valve core	40 minutes
6' - 1/4" hose with core removed	19 minutes
6' - 1/2" hose with core removed	3 minutes

These kits include valve core removal tools, "Y" splitters and larger hoses all designed to facilitate a better evacuation. I've heard over the years that, "I pulled it down to 29 inches" and the technician saying that thought they were doing good. It is important not to rush this process and to remember that the dehydration work

doesn't start until it gets to 29"hg. Clearing up that confusion early is beneficial to good system evacuation. Once the atmosphere inside the refrigerant system reaches 29" the boiling process really begins, there is minor effect on the way down to 29". Using a micron gauge (some of the newer digital gauges have them built in) will help the technician understand where they are in the process. Generally speaking if the micron reading holds at 500 microns, the system is leak-free, moisture-free, and ready to be recharged. If the gauge reading continues to rise after one minute, moisture is still present or there may be a leak in the system. A good reminder here is about POE oil and its hygroscopic properties. Once moisture is absorbed into the POE oil it is not likely to be removed. Safe handling and good refrigeration practices apply.

The types of evacuation mentioned above are deep evacuation and triple evacuation. To define those processes: A deep evacuation is when a technician uses a vacuum pump to pull a vacuum of 250 microns (0.25 mm Hg) or deeper until no moisture or other vapor remains in the system. A vacuum [micron] gauge is used to measure the pressure conditions produced by the vacuum pump. A triple evacuation is a method in which a technician uses a vacuum pump to pull a vacuum of 1500 microns three times. After the first and second vacuum, the technician charges the system back up to a pressure between 0 psig and 3 psig with nitrogen. When a vacuum is pulled on the system, moisture evaporates into vapor. When small amounts of nitrogen are charged into the system, some of the moisture vapor remaining in the system is absorbed into the nitrogen.

The last item to discuss is your tools. There are a variety of pumps, a quality 2 stage vacuum pump is a good choice. The higher cfm of the pump will produce quicker evacuations, if the right tools and processes are used. Always change the pump oil after each use or multiple times during an especially bad evacuation (burnout, high moisture etc...). Clean oil will help in the process, dirty oil will prevent a good vacuum. Evacuation using a 4 port manifold gauge set is a better option than the 3 port set up. Using the valve core removal tool during the process is a benefit; with the cores removed the flow can be increased. Pay attention to your hoses and their seals, they will deteriorate and cause a poor vacuum, replace as needed. Some technicians will have a set of gauges solely for evacuation. Take care of your tools and they will take care of you.
