Florida Air Conditioning Apprenticeship Association (FACAA) is hiring! We are planning for our Fall 2023 school year. We are looking for five new instructors. Below I've listed the items for instruction based on the individual year so you can get a feel for what each year teaches.

First year instruction includes: Safety, Math, Fundamentals of the HVAC trade, Gas Laws, Refrigeration Practices, Basic Refrigeration Cycle, Tools, Brazing and Soldering, Recovery and Evacuation procedures and EPA Certification.

Second Year instruction includes: Safety, Electrical & Electronic Terms, Define AC & DC Current, Describe Series & Parallel Circuits, Discuss Basic Motor Theory, Ohm's Law and Formulas to Solve Electrical Problems, Components of an Electrical Circuit, Common Circuit Controls in A/C Systems, Safety Devices Used in Electrical Systems, Procedures for Servicing Electric motors and components.

Third Year Instruction includes: Safety, Blueprint Reading, Mechanical & Architectural Drawings, Use Basic Drafting Tools, Draw Simple Prints & Sketches, HVAC Formulas, Florida Energy Code, Calculate Heat Loss & Gain using the ACCA Manual J, Equipment sizing using ACCA Manual S, Duct sizing using ACA Manual D, Airflow Testing and Psychrometrics.

Did you see something above that you enjoy even excel at? Why not join our team? My thoughts are, if I enjoy doing this wouldn't others be interested in teaching the next generation? I know there are very well qualified people in our trade who may want to share their knowledge. I can tell you from my 20+ years teaching it's a rewarding experience. The interaction with the students, the relationships you develop, it all worthwhile. I always enjoy it when a former student calls me to say "hey" or ask a question. To me, it makes me feel like I've made a difference. I also enjoy the feedback I get every Monday and Wednesday night from our apprentices. TECHNICIAN'S CORNER

BASIC ELECTRICITY

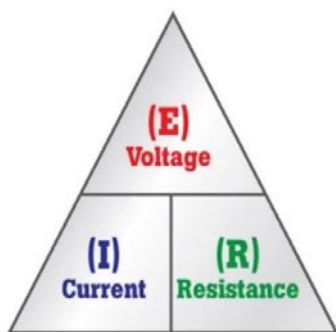

AS A MATTER OF SAFETY AND FUNCTION WE MUST UNDERSTAND ELECTRICITY. IN THE WORLD OF HVAC ELECTRICITY TOUCHES ALMOST ALL ASPECTS, FROM MOTORS AND CONTROLS TO THE ELECTRICITY SUPPLIED TO OPERATE OUR MACHINES. HAVING A GOOD UNDERSTANDING OF THIS CONCEPT WILL HELP PRODUCE BETTER INSTALLATION, MAINTENANCE, AND REPAIR. WHEN DISCUSSING ELECTRICAL WE SHOULD DEFINE OHM'S LAW. WHILE OHM'S LAW IS OBTAINED FROM THE DC CIRCUIT IT IS APPLICABLE TO AC CIRCUITS AS WELL. THERE IS A VARIABLE IN THE ALTERNATING CURRENT, BUT WE WILL DEFINE THAT IN A MORE ADVANCED ARTICLE. OHM'S LAW IS A BASIC PRINCIPLE IN ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING THAT DESCRIBES THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE VOLTAGE, CURRENT, AND RESISTANCE IN AN ELECTRICAL CIRCUIT. THE THREE VARIABLES IN OHM'S LAW ARE REPRESENTED BY THE FOLLOWING LETTERS:

E = VOLTAGE IN VOLTS (V)

I = CURRENT IN AMPERES (A)

R = RESISTANCE IN OHMS (Ω)



FOR THOSE OF YOU WHO ENJOY THE “TRIVIAL PURSUIT OF THINGS,” THIS LAW WAS NAMED FOR GEORG OHM A GERMAN PHYSICIST. HE OBSERVED THESE PRINCIPLES OF ELECTRICAL FACTORS IN THE EARLY 1800'S. OHM'S LAW STATES THAT THE CURRENT FLOWING THROUGH A CONDUCTOR BETWEEN TWO POINTS IS DIRECTLY PROPORTIONAL TO THE VOLTAGE ACROSS THE TWO POINTS AND INVERSELY PROPORTIONAL TO THE RESISTANCE BETWEEN THEM. IN THE BASIC FORM OF THE TRIANGLE THE EQUATIONS ARE DEFINED AS:
VOLTAGE (E) = $I \times R$ OR AMPERAGE (I) \times RESISTANCE (R)
AMPERAGE (I) = $E \div R$ OR VOLTAGE (E) \div RESISTANCE (R)
RESISTANCE (R) = $E \div I$ OR VOLTAGE (E) \div AMPERAGE (I)

WHERE E IS THE VOLTAGE, I IS THE CURRENT IN AMPS, AND R IS THE RESISTANCE IN OHMS. WE CAN USE THE TRIANGLE GRAPH (LEFT) TO TELL US THE FORMULA; BY COVERING THE UNKNOWN VALUE WITH

YOUR THUMB YOU WILL SEE THE FORMULA. AS AN EXAMPLE, IF YOU KNOW THE VOLTAGE AND OHMS, BUT YOU DON'T KNOW THE AMPS. COVER THE “I” WITH YOUR THUMB, YOU'RE LEFT WITH E OVER R ($I = E \div R$). THIS EQUATION CAN BE REARRANGED TO FIND EITHER VOLTAGE, CURRENT, OR RESISTANCE IF ANY TWO OF THE THREE VALUES ARE KNOWN. IN EXAMPLE, TO FIND VOLTAGE, THE EQUATION ABOVE CAN BE REARRANGED AS: $E = I \times R$.

AN EXAMPLE, WE CAN USE OHM'S LAW TO FIND THE OUTPUT OF AN ELECTRICAL HEATER: WE KNOW THAT THERE ARE 3,413 BTUH PER 1 KILOWATT (KILOWATT = 1,000 WATTS). SO, TO FIND THE ACTUAL PERFORMANCE OF AN ELECTRIC HEATER WE CAN MEASURE VOLTAGE TO THE HEATER AND THE AMP DRAW OF THE ELECTRIC HEATER. IN OUR EXAMPLE WE MEASURE 241 VOLTS AND 55 AMPS ON THE HEATER. $V \times I = P$ (WATTS). I.E., 241 VOLTS WITH 55 AMPS = 13,255 WATTS OR 13.26 KILOWATTS. IF 1 KILOWATT EQUALS 3,413 BTUH WE CAN MULTIPLY 13.26 BY 3,413 TO FIND THE HEATER OUTPUT TO BE 45,256 BTUH.

ANOTHER EXAMPLE IS TO FIND WHAT SIZE STANDBY GENERATOR IS NEEDED TO START AND RUN AN A/C UNIT: IN THIS EXAMPLE WE HAVE BEEN ASKED IF A 20-KW WHOLE HOME GENERATOR WILL START AND RUN A 4-TON A/C SYSTEM. WE WILL LOCATE THE LRA OF THE OUTDOOR UNIT AND USE OHM'S LAW TO DETERMINE IF THE 20-KW GENERATOR CAN HANDLE THE LOAD OF A 4 TON A/C SYSTEM. SO, THE LRA OF THE A/C CONDENSER IS 124 AMPS AND THE RLA IS 18.5 AMPS. $V \times I = P$, WE MEASURE 240 VOLTS AT L1, L2 OF THE CONDENSER AND WE MULTIPLY BY 124 AMPS. THE RESULT IS 29,760 WATTS OR 29.7 KILOWATTS. THE 20-KW GENERATOR MAY NOT HAVE ENOUGH IN-RUSH CAPACITY TO START THE COMPRESSOR. THE COMMON MISCONCEPTION HERE IS THAT THE RLA IS ONLY 18.5 AMPS; MULTIPLY 240 VOLTS BY 18.5 AMPS TO FIND 4,440 WATTS OR 4.4 KILOWATTS WHICH IS MUCH LESS THAN THE 29.7 kW OF THE LRA; WHAT WE MUST CONSIDER IS THE COMPRESSOR'S “ROTATING MASS,” SO WE USE THE LRA CURRENT IN THE EQUATION. THE GENERATOR MAY OR MAY NOT BE ABLE TO HANDLE THE IN-RUSH CURRENT. EITHER WAY WE USED OHM'S LAW TO HELP IDENTIFY THE ISSUE.

THIS TRIANGLE IS THE BASIC VERSION OF OHM'S LAW; HOWEVER, THERE IS AN EXPANDED VERSION THAT PROVIDES US WITH ADDITIONAL FORMULAS. ON A SAFETY NOTE, ONLY QUALIFIED TECHNICIANS SHOULD WORK ON LIVE ELECTRIC CIRCUITS. IF YOU HAVE NOT BEEN PROPERLY TRAINED ON HOW TO WORK WITH AND AROUND LIVE ELECTRICITY, PLEASE DO NOT. REMEMBER, WITHOUT A METER, YOU CANNOT “SEE” VOLTAGE OR CURRENT, BUT YOU CAN “FEEL” IT. THERE IS AN ADAGE OUT THERE, “VOLTS HURT BUT AMPS KILL.” ALWAYS USE CAUTION AND YOUR PPE WHEN WORKING AROUND ELECTRICITY.

3. **Fishing Begins:** Lines in the water at 7 a.m.
4. **Official Weigh-In:** Weigh-in begins at 12 noon all fish are to be weighed in at *Tournament Headquarters at the Rafiki Tiki at Riviera Beach Marina , 200 East 13th Street, Riviera Beach*. Boats must be in line and recognized by Official Tournament Weigh-in Staff no later than 4:00 p.m. (If in route, radio communication does not constitute being recognized.) Absolutely no fish will be weighed in from a vessel that has not been officially recognized by Weigh-in Staff by 4:00 p.m. Fishing stops and lines are out of the water at 3:00 p.m. All fish must be weighed-in directly from the vessel. Weigh Master has right to disqualify any fish for freshness. In case of a tie – the first fish weighed in wins.
All boats must adhere to the State and Federal required size and bag limit on the three tournament fish categories. A salt water-fishing license is required. Entered fish eligible for only one cash "place" prize per boat.
5. **Fishing Stops:** Lines out of the water 3 p.m.
6. **Scales Close:** 4 p.m.
7. **Awards Ceremony:** *Immediately following at Rafiki Tiki at Riviera Beach Marina.*
8. **Prizes:** First, Second and Third Largest Fish in any or all categories of Kingfish, Dolphin or Wahoo. *First Place - \$1000.00; Second place \$750.00, Third place - \$500.00, Cash Prizes limited to one per boat. There will be many other prize giveaways.*

1. Boat and anglers must be registered with PBACCA Tournament Committee. Late entries will be taken up to 7:00 p.m. Thursday, June 15th at Captain's Meeting. No exceptions.
2. *Early registration fee is \$275.00 per boat for PBACCA members, Non-members \$325.00. Entries received after Friday, May 27th 3:30 p.m. are \$300 PBACCA members, \$350 non-members. Early registrations are eligible for the Captain's Party prize drawing.*
3. Entry Fee includes 4 anglers per boat, 4 tournament T-Shirts, and 4 dinner tickets for Saturday, June 17th. Additional anglers are (\$50 before May 19th, \$55 after.) Additional dinner tickets for June 17th tournament ceremony may be purchased in advance for \$20 and additional T-shirts may be purchased at the Captain's Meeting for \$15 (as long as supplies last.)
4. Fish may be taken by rod and reel only. Down riggers and planers are permitted. No wire lines.
5. Dead bait, live bait or artificials may be used.
6. Chartered boats are allowed.
7. In case of a tie, the first fish weighed in wins.
8. Fishing hours are 7 a.m. - 3 p.m.
9. If you have a fish on the line, beyond the lines out time you may continue to fish, but you must radio into the committee boat. Inform them of your boat number and circumstances. All boats are still required to be in line and recognized by Official Tournament Weigh-In Staff no later than 4:00 p.m. weigh in by 4:00 p.m. to be eligible for cash awards.
10. Tournament Committee will have the final decision.
11. All boats must adhere to the State and Federal required size and bag limit on the three tournament fish categories. A salt water-fishing license is required. Entered fish eligible for only one cash "place" prize per boat.
12. PBACCA has the right to cancel the tournament and return all entry fees if the 15-boat minimum has not been met by three weeks prior to the tournament date.

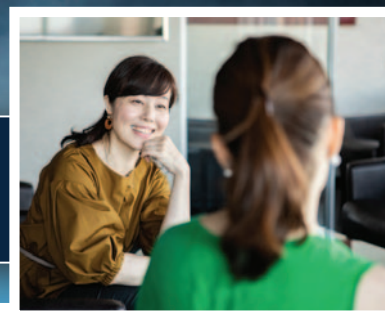

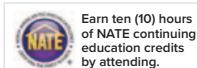
